The *chassan* is the son of Harav Yaakov Yitzchak Elchanan Rottenberg, son of Harav Moshe Rottenberg, Voidaslover Rav, *shlita*, and son-in-law of Harav Tzvi Meizlish, *zt"l*, Veitzen-er Rav.

Aleksander Rebbe in America

The Aleksander Rebbe, *shlita*, traveled last week from Eretz Yisrael for a wedding of a Chasid on Lag BaOmer, in Lakewood.

The Rebbe left Eretz Yisrael on Wednesday night, after lighting the *hadlakah* at his *beis medrash* in Bnei Brak, arriving in time for the wedding on Thursday, before *shkiah*.

The Rebbe will spend two weeks in America, on behalf of *mosdos* Aleksander in Eretz Yisrael and will return to Eretz Yisrael ahead of Shavuos.

Shabbos Marks the *Yahrtzeit* Of the *Shaarei Hayashar* of Liska

This upcoming Shabbos, 27 Iyar, will mark the 72nd *yahrtzeit* of the Liska Rebbe, Harav Tzvi Hersh Friedlander, *Hy"d*, author of the acclaimed *sefer Shaarei Hayashar* who was

murdered in Auschwitz together with almost his entire family, his *kehillah* and the majority of Hungarian Jewry, who perished in that period in 5704/1944.

Named for his grandfather, the progenitor of the Liska dynasty, Harav Tzvi Hersh of Liska, known as the *Ach Pri Tevuah*, he was renowned as a Torah scholar of epic proportions. The Liska Rebbe was a member of Hungary's elite rabbinic council which oversaw all matters pertaining to its functions as a *kehillah*. In fact, when he would travel twice a year to Budapest, difficult *she'eilos* were left waiting for him to rule the *halachos*.

Sadly, the over 40 *sefarim* authored by him were tragically lost during the upheaval during the deportations to Auschwitz.

Yet, the *sefer Shaarei Hayashar* which was printed before the war provides a glimpse, allowing one to realize his greatness in Torah — both in *nigleh* and in *nistar*.

Although the Holocaust consumed most of

his family, his grandson, Harav Tzvi Hersh Friedlander, the current Liska Rebbe, *shlita*, carries forth the illustrious dynasty of his forebears and will commemorate the *yahrtzeit* in the Liska *beis medrash* located at 1449 50th Street, Boro Park, where a special *tisch* will be conducted during *shalosh seudos*.

Yahrtzeit of Harav Meir Bransdorfer Marked

The seventh *yahrtzeit* of Harav Meir Bransdorfer, *zt"l*, leading *Dayan* in the Eidah Hachareidis, was marked last Shabbos, 20 Iyar.

The Toldos Avraham Yitzchak Rebbe, *shlita*, conducted a *tisch* in honor of the *yahrtzeit* of Harav Meir, who served as the Rav of the Toldos Avraham Yitzchak community.
