Liska Melave Malka This Motzei Shabbos

The annual Melave Malka of Khal Ateres Tzvi M'Liska will take place this upcoming *Motzei Shabbos*, *Parashas Mishpatim*, February 9 at the Liska Bais Hamedrash, which is located at 1449 50th Street, in the Borough Park section of Brooklyn.

The Liska Bais Hamedrash was founded over 50 years ago by the previous Liska Rav, Admor Reb Yozef Friedlander, and is under the leadership of the current Liska Rav, Rav Tzvi Hersh Friedlander, *shlita*. It serves the entire Borough Park community with dedication and welcomes everyone to its warm *davening* and Torah *shiurim*.

This year's melave malka will also commemorate the *yahrzeit* of the previous Liska Rav, *zt"l*, who was *niftar* at the young age of 52, 31 years ago. The Rav settled in Borough Park in 1947, and served as a beacon of light to the entire community as he established one of the first Chassidische *Kehillas* in Borough Park. *Divrei Torah* will be heard from the current Liska Rav, *shlita*, and from the Liska *Dayan*, Rav Avrohom Friedlander, *shlita*, who also serves as the Rav of Maimonides Medical Center, in memory of their illustrious father, *zt"l*. This year's Melave Malka will also be celebrated to express our gratitude to *Hashem* for the recovery of Reb Yozef Leifer, a grandson of the Liska Rav, *zt"l*, from the injuries he sustained in a recent terrorist attack in Yerushalayim. ■

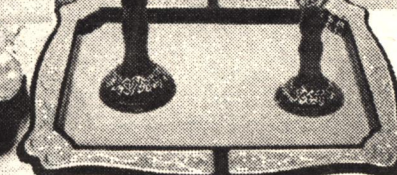

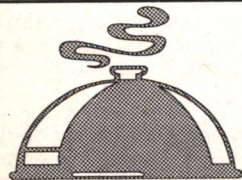
